PARKING LOT ETIQUETTE: Curbside procedures for everyone.

We apologize for the inconvenience cause due to our small space, but please bear with us. Safety is very important be extra cautious while you are dropping off or picking up your children.

I would like to thank everyone and appreciated all your patience. I would like to take this privilege remind you again the procedures of the curbside for Toddlers, Pre-Primary and Elementary.

1. Practice patience, courtesy and respect.
2. Observe slow speed limits. Do not exceed 10 miles per hour.
3. Curbside service is available from 8:10-8:30am, 11:30-11:45am and 3:15-3:30pm. Please note there is no curbside drop-off for PM half day or Kids

Club programs.

4. Stay in your car at all times during curbside drop-off. Remain in the car for curbside pick-up until you reach the buckling in area. Children will be removed from your car by Schoolhouse staff.
5. Put your car in PARK while your child is getting in or out of the car.
6. Stay in the queue line until your car is ready to exit from the lead position.
7. Pulling outside and around other cars jeopardizes the safety of children and staff. For pick-up, please pull forward to the designated area to buckle your child into their car seat.
7. NEVER leave your child unattended and standing in the parking lot.
8. Remain alert at all times. Please, no cell-phone conversa-

tions when picking up and dropping off your child, or driving into the school parking lot- for the safety of the staff, your child and yourself.

9. Schoolhouse reserves the right to discontinue the curbside service for families in violation of these procedures.
10. If you chose to park at any time, please remember to park only in designated parking areas.
11. Please note that all children under the age of 8 should be in a child restraint device. This is a federal law. Please remember, when you are running late or become impatient with the curbside procedure, hasty reactions put the safety of your child, the safety of Schoolhouse staff and all pedestrians in jeopardy.
